Campbell saw its six game winning streak come to an end Saturday at North Alabama, as Joe Gurley's field goal as time expired lifted the Lions over the Camels, 25-24. The winning streak marked Campbell's longest in modern era history. The loss was Campbell's first against a FCS opponent this season.

Campbell rushed for a season-high 269 yards on 56 carries on the day, using a balanced

Press Credentials

Press credentials are limited to working members of the print and electronic media, as well as photographers and videographers. Photographers are restricted to designated areas of the field

Interview Policies

The Campbell Athletic Communications Department will attempt to arrange all reasonable requests for interviews with Fighting Camel head coach Mike Minter and team members. With respect to practice, study and personal time, a few guidelines should be followed.

Player Interviews

All interview requests with Campbell football players must be arranged through the Campbell Athletic Communications Department. Players are generally available for interviews immediately following practice sessions and games. If a media member desires to set up a telephone interview, this can be arranged.

Post Game Interviews

Following each home game, Campbell head coach Mike Minter and requested players will be brought to the media room for interviews following a 10 minute cooling off period. The Campbell locker room is closed to all individuals with the exception of authorized team or university personnel. Visiting head coaches and any requested players are available upon request.

Road Interviews

Interviews with Coach Minter or team members away from campus or contact outside of playing sites must be arranged through the athletic communications department. Every attempt will be made to satisfy the interview request within reason.

Head Coach Interviews

Requests for interviews with Coach Minter should be made through Director of Athletic Communications Jason Williams at (910) 814-4367 or (910) 228-6908.

Home Game Services

Working press facilities are available at Barker-Lane Stadium / Ed Gore Field. Telephone lines, high-speed internet connections and wireless internet connections are available upon request.

Campbell Athletics Communications will provide a pre-game snack to working media members in the press box. A full NCAA box score and play-by-play sheets will be distributed as soon as possible following the completion of each game. Stats are also provided to press row after each quarter, and live stats are available throughout each game.

Big South Conference Public Relations

Throughout the football season, the Big South Conference staff will provide updated statistics weekly for each conference team, plus a weekly release, to the media through BigSouthSports. com. Big South games – and all Campbell home games – are available via ESPN+ and ESPN3.

Radio / Internet Broadcasts

Announcer positions for radio broadcasts of Fighting Camel football are located inside the Barker-Lane Stadium press box. Under reciprocal agreements, the official designated originating station of the visiting team is allowed to originate radio broadcasts without charge. attacked of Johnathan Hawkins (67), Bryant Barr (60), C.J. Freeman (53), Cameron Davis (46) and Hajj-Malik Williams (43). Davis and Williams both found the end zone on the ground, while Hawkins hauled in a 10-yard TD pass from Williams with 45 seconds to go in the third, bringing the Camels within a point at 22-21.

Colin Gary gave Campbell its first lead since early in the second quarter with his 39 yard field goal, the redshirt senior's eight consecutive make, going up 24-22 with 10:46 to play. Both teams traded punts on two straight possessions before Gurley's game-winning kick.

Williams also completed 7-of-16 pass attempts for 88 yards and a touchdown, completing throws to six receivers.

CAMELS RECEIVING FCS TOP-25 VOTES

For the sixth consecutive week, Campbell is receiving votes in the FCS top-25 polls. Following its loss at UNA, Campbell picked up one vote in the STATS FCS Top-25.

This is the third different season that the Camels have received top-25 votes, also picking up tallies in 2011 and 2018.

WILLIAMS NAMED TO JERRY RICE AWARD WATCH LIST

Campbell quarterback Hajj-Malik Williams has been named to the STATS Jerry Rice Award watch list, presented annually to the FCS freshman of the year.

A freshman from Atlanta, Ga., Williams has thrown for 1,496 yards and 15 touchdowns, completing nearly 60 percent of his passes, while starting all eight games for the 6-2 Camels, off to their best start in program history. The QB has also rushed for 418 yards and five more touchdowns.

His 15 passing TDs are tied for second on the Campbell single-season charts, while his 1,496 passing yards stands sixth in CU single-season history. Williams has accounted for a touchdown throw and a rushing score in four games this season, ranking third in the Big South in total offense, and leading all conference freshman.

Williams has been named Big South Freshman of the Week, as well as honorable mention STATS FCS Freshman of the Week four times this season.

LEADING THE CAMELS

In addition to Williams' 1,914 yards of total offense, Johnathan Hawkins has rushed for a team-high 446 yards with five touchdowns, adding another receiving TD, while Cameron Davis has posted 373 yards rushing and two touchdowns. Bryant Barr also adds a pair of rushing TDs.

Caleb Snead owns a team-best 455 receiving yards with five touchdowns, while Davarius Bargnare has hauled in 331 yards and two TDs. Jalen Kelsey tacks on a team-high six receiving TDs with 314 yards

Justice Galloway-Velazquez paces the CU defense with 64 tackles, adding 2.5 sacks, two forced fumbles, a fumble recovery, an interception and a blocked kick. Darion Slade has also posted 44 stops with an interception and a forced fumble, while Damien Dozier has collected 45 tackles with

SCOUTING KENNESAW STATE

The Owls checked in at No. 11 in AFCA Coaches' Poll and No. 15 in the STATS FCS Poll following a 45-21 loss to Monmouth last week, ending the Owls' 12-game Big South win streak.

Kennesaw State is one of four teams in the nation to rank in the top-10 in scoring offense and scoring defense, ranking No. 3 in the nation in offense (39.1) and No. 10 in the county in defense (17.7). The KSU defense ranks seventh in the nation in stopping the run, giving up just 93 yards per game on the ground. The Owls have only surrendered 100-plus rush yards three times this year.

QB Daniel David leads the Owls with 14 rushing touchdowns, rushing for 448 yards, while Bronson Rechsteiner owns 613 yards on the ground with five TDs. David has also thrown for 551 yards and two more scores. On the defensive side, Bryson Armstrong leads the way with 60 tackles, including 6.5 stops for loss.

Campbell will be taking on a nationally-ranked opponent for the fourth time in program history. The Camels are 0-3 all-time against ranked foes, last taking on a top-25 opponent in 2018 at then No. 2 Kennesaw State. Saturday will mark the first time Campbell has hosted a ranked opponent at Barker-Lane Stadium.

NEXT UP

The Camels will host another nationally-ranked Big South foe, wrapping up their 2019 home slate with Monmouth on November 16. Campbell finishes out the regular season on the road at Charleston Southern on November 23.

PACKING BARKER-LANE

Campbell welcomed a crowd of 6,783 for its 2019 homecoming game against Hampton, setting a Barker-Lane Stadium record. It was the 13th crowd of 6,000 or more since the facility's expansion in 2013. So far this season, Campbell is averaging 5,974 per game at 5,500 seat Barker-Lane Stadium, one of eight FCS schools in the country averaging a sellout (Merrimack, Sacred Heart, Central Arkansas, ETSU, Rhode Island, Charleston Southern and Montana State).

HOME SWEET HOME

The Camels are off to a 4-0 start at home for the first time in program history. Campbell opened its 2019 home slate with a 38-14 win over Division II Shaw, winning its fifth straight home opener, following that performance with a 31-29 win over Davidson, a 28-14 victory over Presbyterian and Saturday's 31-16 win over Hampton. With two home games remaining, Campbell has already matched a school record for home wins with four (2011, 2014, 2018).

RUNNING CAMELS

Campbell rushed for a season-best 269 yards on 56 carries at UNA. The Camels have topped 200 yards rushing five times this season, and four times in their last five outings.

GARY HITS EIGHTH STRAIGHT KICK

With another field goal at North Alabama, Colin Gary has made eight consecutive field goals this season, one short of tying Adam Willets' program record nine straight from 2009. Gary has made 8-of-9 tries on the season. The redshirt senior has also hit all 26 extra point attempts this season.

BRINGING THE HITS

With a game-high 10 tackles at UNA, Ray Miller became the sixth Camel defender to lead the team in tackles in a game. Darion Slade is the only Campbell player to lead the team in tackles on multiple occasions this season, topping the list three times (at Mercer, Presbyterian, Hampton).

CAMELS WIN FIRST THREE BIG SOUTH TESTS

For the third time in program history, Campbell is 3-0 to begin conference play, also winning its first three Pioneer Football League games in 2014 and 2017. The Camels started 4-0 in both of those years.

HITTING THE CENTURY MARK

Hajj-Malik Williams (100) and Johnathan Hawkins (105) are the first Campbell duo this season with 100 rushing yards in the same game. Including Williams and Hawkins, four Camels also notched 100 or more all-purpose yards, with Caleb Snead adding 104 receiving yards and Jalen Kelsey leading the way with 166 on 135 kickoff return yards and 31 receiving. Kelsey's 166 all-purpose yards are the most in a game this season.

So far this season, six different Camels have reached the century mark eight rushing or receiving, with Hawkins running for 100-plus twice.

WOOTEN NAMED SEMIFINALIST FOR CAMPBELL TROPHY

Campbell tight end Michael Wooten is one of 185 semifinalists for the 2019 William V. Campbell Trophy® Presented by Mazda. Celebrating its 30th year in 2019, the award recognizes an individual as the absolute best football scholar-athlete in the nation for his combined academic success, football performance and exemplary leadership. The group includes 71 nominees from the NCAA Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS), 39 from the NCAA Football Championship Subdivision (FCS), 19 from NCAA Division II, 49 from NCAA Division III and seven from the NAIA.

QUICK HITS



Campbell saw its six game winning streak come to an end last week on the road at North Alabama. The Camels' six wins this season also ties a school record for victories in a single season, also accomplished in 2011, 2017 and 2018. CU owns six wins in each of the last three seasons, clinching a winning season for three straight years, another program record. Campbell's 6-2 start is an all-time best through eight games. Campbell's previous best for consecutive wins came in 2011 with five in a row.

Campbell's triple overtime win at Gardner-Webb marked its 12th victory in its last 13 games against North Carolina competition. The Camels won nine in a row over Tar Heel State foes from 2014 (Davidson) until 2018, falling to Gardner-Webb to end the streak. Campbell is 3-0 against North Carolina schools in 2019, topping Shaw 38-14, Davidson 31-29 and Gardner-Webb 49-47.

Campbell opened its 2019 home slate with a 38-14 win over Division II Shaw, winning its fifth straight home opener, following that performance with a 31-29 win over Davidson, a 28-14 victory over Presbyterian and Saturday's 31-16 win over Hampton. With two home games remaining, Campbell has already matched a school record for home wins with four (2011, 2014, 2018).

Campbell will be taking on a nationally-ranked opponent for the fourth time in program history Saturday against No. 11 Kennesaw State. The Camels are 0-3 all-time against ranked foes, last taking on a top-25 opponent in 2018 at then No. 2 Kennesaw State. Saturday will mark the first time Campbell has hosted a ranked opponent at Barker-Lane Stadium.

So far this season, the redshirt senior has started all seven of CU's games at tight end, extending his start streak to 28. Wooten was a Big South All-Academic Team member in 2018, also garnering Phil Steele Second Team Big South All-Conference honors. Named 2019 Preseason All-Big South, Wooten totaled 13 catches for 73 yards last season. Wooten is a kinesiology major (pre-physical therapy), set to graduate in December 2019.

WILLIAMS, SANTIAGO TAKE BIG SOUTH WEEKLY HONORS (10/28)

After Campbell's dramatic 49-47 triple overtime win at Gardner-Webb, two Camels have been named Big South Players of the Week.

For the fourth time this season and the second straight week, quarterback Hajj-Malik Williams has been tabbed the Big South Freshman of the Week, while another Campbell freshman, Alex Santiago, has been named the league's Special Teams Player of the Week.

Williams completed 22-of-36 passes for 208 yards with two touchdowns and an interception, adding 100 yards rushing and two more scores for the Camels in the OT win. Completing a season-high 22 passes, Williams is the second player in program history to have 200 or more passing yards, 100 rushing yards, and multiple passing and rushing touchdowns in a game. It's the fifth 200-plus yard passing game for the freshman. Williams has passed for 1408 yards and 14 touchdowns, also running for 375 yards and four scores.

Santiago, meanwhile, picked up Greg Streater's blocked punt and returned the ball 41 yards for a touchdown with no time remaining, helping Campbell force overtime at Gardner-Webb. Santiago's return marked the longest blocked punt returned for a touchdown (41-yards) in school history, eclipsing Paul Constantine's 10 yard return in 2011 against Apprentice, CU's only other blocked punt for a TD

Through nine weeks of the 2019 season, Camels have earned Big South player of the week honors 13 times.

TURNING DEFENSE INTO POINTS

Alex Santiago's blocked punt returned for a touchdown at Gardner-Webb marked Campbell's second non-offensive touchdown of the season, joining Kam Prewitt's 44-yard interception return in the second quarter at Mercer. Santiago's return was Campbell's second blocked punt returned for a touchdown in the modern era, joining Paul Constantine's 2011 performance against Apprentice.

Prewitt's interception was the 14th pick-six in Campbell's modern era (since 2008), and Prewitt's first as a Camel.

While Santiago's return technically does not count as a takeaway, Campbell has scored 35 points off 12 takeaways this season. The Camels scored a season-high 21 points off turnovers in their 31-29 win over Davidson in week four.

Campbell has scored at least two non-offensive TDs in 10 of its 12 seasons of modern era football, notching a school record five in 2017.

WINNING THE STATE

Campbell's triple overtime win at Gardner-Webb marked its 12th victory in its last 13 games against North Carolina competition. The Camels won nine in a row over Tar Heel State foes from 2014 (Davidson) until 2018, falling to Gardner-Webb to end the streak.

Campbell is 3-0 against North Carolina schools in 2019, topping Shaw 38-14, Davidson 31-29 and Gardner-Webb 49-47.

COMING TO AN END ZONE NEAR YOU

Caleb Snead hauled in yet another touchdown catch for the Camels in the win over Gardner-Webb, posting five grabs for 104 yards. The redshirt sophomore has caught a TD pass in four of Campbell's eight games this season, owning at least one touchdown catch in 12 of his 19 career games, and 14 total touchdowns over that span. With his 33 yard touchdown catch in the second quarter against Davidson, Snead reached the 1,000 career receiving yards milestone, hitting the mark in just 14 career games – the fastest in school history (previous Aaron Blockmon, 17 games as a redshirt sophomore in 2016). Snead is third in school history with 1,265 receiving yards, passing Harrison Jordan (2008-11) with his 104 yard outing at GWU.

Former Carolina Panthers standout and Nebraska Football Hall of Famer Mike Minter completed his sixth season as head football coach at Campbell University in 2018.

Over the last six seasons, Campbell has reset nearly every school record in the books. Camels have been named first or second team all-conference 29 times, while 37 have been tabbed honorable mention all-league.

Minter led the Camels through a successful transition to the Big South Conference in 2018, their first season as a scholarship program. Campbell finished 2018 at 6-5 overall and 1-4 in its inaugural Big South season. With six wins, the Camels secured back-to-back winning seasons for the first time in the program's modern era (since 2008), and tied an overall program record for victories.

In addition, seven Camels were named to All-Big South teams, with freshman wide receiver Caleb Snead and redshirt junior punter Brad Dennis headlining the league's first team. Snead was also named First Team Freshman All-America, the Camels' second straight season with a freshman All-America selection.

The Camels led the FCS in fewest passing yards allowed per game (122.5), while ranking 25th in total defense (335.4 yards per game). CU also ranked in the FCS' top-10 in fewest sacks allowed (0.82 per game), finishing the year sixth.

Campbell finished 2017 6-5 overall and 5-3 in PFL play, matching the program's best overall and conference records in its 10 year history. The Camels also set a record for road wins (3).

Ten Camels earned All-PFL recognition, with safety Carolos Merritt and defensive end Emmanuel Olenga taking First Team nods. Quarterback Daniel Smith, wide receiver Aaron Blockmon and offensive tackle Shuler Littleton were also tabbed Second Team All-PFL, while five others were named honorable mention All-PFL.

Smith was named the PFL's Offensive Freshman of the Year, and was a finalist for the STATS Jerry Rice Award for FCS freshman player of the year, finishing fourth in the final voting. Smith finished the 2017 regular season with the fourth-most rushing yards in the country, with his 1,272 yards on the ground leading all FCS freshmen and quarterbacks. Smith set Campbell single-season records for rushing yards, total offense (3,161), all-purpose yards (1,272) and touchdowns responsible for (30). After just one season, Smith is already Campbell's career leader in touchdown passes with 18.

The Camels set 16 team single-season school records in 2017, plus 19 individual single-season marks on the way to their historic season. Additionally, CU set Barker-Lane Stadium records for average, total and single-game attendance for the second straight season.

The Camels ranked fifth in the nation in total defense in 2015 (279.3 per game), standing third in team sacks per game (3.55) and ninth in scoring defense (17.7). The team shattered program records for all three categories, adding single season marks for tackles for loss (85.0) and total sacks (38.0).

16 Camels were honored on the conference's All-PFL teams following the 2015 season, with junior running back De'Shawn Jones, redshirt senior defensive lineman Ugonna Awuruonye and senior defensive lineman Greg Milhouse Jr. all receiving First Team All-PFL accolades.

The PFL 2015 Freshman Defensive Player of the Year went to Campbell's Jack Ryan. Four Camels were also named to the 2015 Academic All-PFL teams.

The offseason saw another Campbell first, with defensive tackle Greg Milhouse Jr. (New York Giants) and long snapper Danny Dillon (Arizona Cardinals) both signing NFL contracts.

In Minter's first season as head coach at CU, the Camels set 21 offensive team records, including rushing yards (2,800), passing yards (2,436), and total offense (5,236). The Camels also established four defensive marks, including sacks (27), and posted three team records on special teams.

Senior Kurt Odom became Campbell's first football All-America selection, earning Third Team honors from the Sports Network. Odom was also named First Team All-PFL while seven Camels took home honorable mention nods.

In May 2014, CU quarterback Brian Hudson signed a contract with the Canadian Football League's Calgary Stampeders.

Minter picked up his first win as a collegiate head coach in his home debut as the Camels cruised to a 56-21 triumph over UVA-Wise.

Minter, a member of two national championship teams at Nebraska and the Panthers' 2003 Super Bowl squad, joined the Fighting Camel program after serving as assistant coach at Liberty University in 2012 and Johnson C. Smith University in 2011. He also brought head coaching experience from First Assembly Christian School in Concord, where he guided his teams to 33 victories and two state titles in three seasons.

During his 10-year NFL career, Minter earned a starting safety role six games into his rookie year in 1997, and held that position until he retired after the 2006 season. A second-round draft choice, he helped lead the Panthers to three playoff trips, the 2003 NFC Championship and a berth in Super Bowl XXXVII.

In the Super Bowl against the New England Patriots, Minter suffered a broken left foot in the third quarter, but remained in the game and collected a career-high 18 tackles. At the time of his retirement, he held Panthers franchise records for starts (141), consecutive starts (94), fumble recoveries (11) and interceptions returned for touchdowns (4).

At Liberty, Minter worked as special teams coordinator/assistant defensive coach under head coach Turner Gill. He mentored three 2012 Big South all-conference performers in long snapper Richard Wright, place kicker John Lunsford and punter Grant Bowden.

During his time at Johnson C. Smith, Minter helped the Golden Bulls dramatically improve in many phases of the game. Under his guidance as assistant head coach, defensive passing game coordinator and special teams coordinator, JCSU ranked fifth in the nation in punt return yardage in 2011.

Minter was a two-time national champion at Nebraska (1994 and 1995) where he played linebacker, free safety and strong safety for the Cornhuskers. He was a three-time all-conference performer and was inducted into the Nebraska Football Hall of Fame in 2006. He graduated in 1997 with a Bachelor of Science degree in engineering.

Born Jan. 15, 1974, in Cleveland, Ohio, Minter led the State of Oklahoma in rushing yards (1,589) as a senior at Lawton High School in 1991. He was an all-state performer, National Honor Society member and also averaged 21 points per game on the Lawton basketball team.

In addition to playing and coaching football, Minter is CEO of Minter Enterprises, a multi-faceted business impacting real estate development, general contracting and construction, business consultation, publishing, public speaking engagements and a non-profit organization focused on youth development.

Minter and his wife Kim have four children – Michael Jr., Isaiah, McKenna and Brianna.
