

2019 Hampton Football Game 11 vs. #11/16 Kennesaw St.

GAME 11 - SENIOR DAY WITH NATIONALLY-RANKED OWLS

Hampton starts its most challenging stretch in many years with the first of two nationally-ranked teams to end the season hosting Kennesaw State.

This is the first-ever matchup with the Owls who come into the game ranked 11th in the AFCA Coaches Poll and 16th in the STATS FCS Poll.

LAST GAME VS. CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

CHARLESTON, S.C. -- A 24-yard scoring pass from Darius Douglas to Garrius Schwarting in the first overtime period lifted homestanding Charleston Southern Buccaneers to a 27-20 overtime win over Hampton on Saturday night.

For the second straight game, Hampton scored on its opening possession as the Pirates drove 73 yards in six plays with Deondre Francois connecting with Jadakis Bonds on a 33-yard scoring pass. The extra-point attempt failed as Hampton held a 6-0 lead at the 11:03 mark. Shai McKenzie got 18 of those yards.

Charleston Southern hit a big play on its second drive with a 59-yard pass to get down to the Hampton 13. The Pirates held them to a 25-yard field goal by Alex Usry with 8:14 remaining in the quarter for a 6-3 Hampton lead.

The tandem of Francois and Bonds culminated a 12-play, 65-yard drive with a five-yard scoring pass with 3:15 left to give Hampton a 13-3 lead.

Charleston Southern got back into the contest on the heels of a two-yard run by Darius Douglas to complete a 72-yard scoring drive and trail 13-10 with 5:28 left in the half.

He put the Buccaneers in the lead for the first time with a 19-yard run to lead 17-13 with 4:35 left. Douglas connected with Tyree Baptiste on a 42-yard connection to set up the scoring run.

The tandem of Bonds and Francois struck again to finish off a 76-yard, 10-play drive with a five-yard touchdown reception with 8:26 remaining. That reception tied Bonds with Marquay McDaniel for the single-season touchdown reception mark with 14. A 37-yard field goal by Usry with 4:07 left evened the game at 20.

Francois was 26-of-47 for 298 yards and three touchdowns. Bonds caught 10 passes for 91 yards, while KeyRon Catlett had eight for 96 yards and Marcel Paul had seven for 99 yards. Shai McKenzie topped the rushing with 58 yards on 20 carries to snap his four-game 100-yard streak. He will enter next week's game 33 yards from 1,000 on the season.

Defensively, Keenan Marr had seven tackles, while DeAndre Faulk, Oral Varcciann and Caleb Brown added five apiece.

Highlights vs. Charleston Southern

Deondre Francois moved into second on single season TDs at Hampton with 23 and in single season yards with 2,362. He is 351 yards from the single season record.

Jadakis Bonds is now tied for most TD receptions in a season with 14 and he's now alone in NCAA FCS with 14. His 17 in the his career is seventh all time at Hampton.

Shai McKenzie is 33 yards from 1,000 this season and to

become the first 1,000-yard running back since Jeremiah Schwartz in 2012.

HEAD COACH ROBERT PRUNTY



Robert Prunty, a veteran with more than 30 years of football experience as a player and coach and a four-time conference recruiter-of-the-year honoree with two different Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) programs, is entering his second season as head coach at Hampton University.

"I am excited to welcome Coach Prunty back to our Home by the Sea," said Hampton University President Dr. William R.

Harvey. "Coach Prunty's record of consistent, sustained outstanding performance will take our football program to the next level. I enthusiastically welcome him to Hampton Nation."

In his first season, the Pirates ventured far and wide playing a FCS independent season and finished with a 7-3 record. The Pirates saw action in Mississippi, South Carolina, Iowa, New York and New Jersey for their road games in 2018 and ended the season with a six-game winning streak. Offensively, the Pirates put up 50+ points on three occasions and

had two games scoring in the 40s.

Prunty served last season as East Carolina University's associate head coach, defensive coordinator and defensive line coach. Prior to that, he served four years as the University of Cincinnati's associate head coach and defensive ends coach and three years as co-defensive coordinator. Before impacting the Bearcat program, Prunty spent three seasons under Tommy Tuberville at Texas Tech, 2010-2012, directing the Red Raiders' defensive ends.

"I am honored to be named the Head Football Coach of Hampton University," said Prunty. "I would like to thank President Dr. William R. Harvey and Athletic Director Eugene Marshall Jr. for this opportunity. I will give all that I have to make this program successful for our University, Alumni, fans, and our community. There is plenty of work to be done until we reach our goal, but we will all work tirelessly to get us there."

In seven combined seasons at the FBS level, Prunty has been part of five bowl appearances, a conference co-championship and was recognized by Scout.com as the Big 12 Conference Recruiter-of-the-Year in 2010-11 and 2011-12 before earning similar honors as the American Athletic Conference's (AAC) top recruiter in 2012-13 and 2013-14.

Prunty helped guide the Bearcats to the Belk, Military and Hawai'i Bowls in 2013, 2014 and 2015, respectively, and



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worked with 10 All-AAC defensive selections. Linebacker Eric Wilson was a first-team pick in 2016 after leading the league and standing fifth nationally with 10.8 tackles per game, while Cortez Broughton (2016), Silverberry Mouhon (2015, 2013), Terrell Hartsfield (2014) and Jordan Stepp (2013) were all honored as the conference's top linemen.

While at Texas Tech, he was part of a strong defensive turnaround in 2012 as the Red Raiders finished the regular season ranked 39th at the FBS level in total defense after standing 114th in 2011. Lineman Kerry Hyder was an All-Big 12 selection after ranking third on the squad with 56 tackles and a team-leading 14.0 tackles for lost yardage and six sacks. He tallied 10.5 TFLs during Big 12 play alone to lead the conference.

Prunty, who joined the Red Raiders in 2010 from Hargrave Military Academy, put his mark on the TTU football program almost immediately after playing an integral part in signing the highest-rated recruiting class in school history in 2011. In addition to Scout.com, he was honored by Rivals.com as the Big 12 Conference's top-rated recruiter.

His player evaluation and relationship cultivation skills produced Texas Tech's second-highest rated class in school history in 2012 and his efforts were saluted by both Scout.com and Fox Sports.

From 2002 to 2009, Prunty served as head football coach at Hargrave Military Academy where 27 of his players went on to the National Football League - two as first-round draft choices.

Prior to his tenure at Hargrave, Prunty led a resurgence at Gretna (Va.) High School, redirecting a program that lost 44 consecutive games between 1991 and 1995 into an 11-1 product during his final season in 2001. Gretna went on to become a powerhouse, winning multiple state championships.

Prunty is a Chatham, Va., native and a 1983 Hargrave Military Academy graduate. He split his collegiate career between Hampton University and Alabama A&M, where he graduated in 1988.

He is married to Kimberly and has one son Robert Prunty, Jr. and a daughter Gabrielle.
