THE GAME



- After winning its third-straight Big Sky title, it's FCS Playoff time for Weber State football. The Wildcats take on Kennesaw State in the second round of the FCS Playoffs Saturday.
- The game will kickoff at 1 p.m. from Stewart Stadium in Ogden. The game will be televised and streamed on ESPN3 and WatchESPN with Michael Reghi and Dustin Fox calling the action. The game can be seen at WatchESPN.com and the ESPN app.
- Radio broadcast will be on 1430 KLO and 1430kloradio.com with Steve Klauke and former Wildcat head coach and athletic director Jerry Graybeal on the call.
- Live stats will be at WeberStateSports.com and the Weber State app.

OPENING DRIVE

- Weber State ended the regular season with a 9-3 overall record and a 7-1 record in Big Sky play. WSU clinched its third-straight conference title for the first time in school history.
- The Wildcats earned the number three seed in the FCS Playoffs.
- Kennesaw State is 11-2 on the season. The Owls opened the playoffs with a 28-21 win at Wofford on Saturday. The Owls are ranked ninth in the nation in the AFCA coaches poll and are 6-1 on the road this season. Kennesaw State leads the nation in rushing offense.
- Weber State led the Big Sky with 14 players on the all-conference team with five earning first team honors. Jonah Williams was named the Big Sky co-Defensive Player of the Year.
- Jay Hill is his sixth season as head coach of the Wildcats. Hill has a career record of 45-29 at Weber State. Hill is 33-14 in Big Sky games.
- This will be Weber State's eighth appearance in the FCS Playoffs and the fourth-straight year the 'Cats have advanced to the playoffs.
- Weber State has advanced to the quarterfinals in each of the last two seasons.
- This is the first ever meeting between Weber State and Kennesaw State and WSU's first ever game against a team from the Big South Conference.
- This season the Wildcats are celebrating 100 years of football at Weber State and the 150th year of college football.

WEBER STATE FOOTBALL HISTORY

Weber State began playing Division I football in 1962 and one year later, became a charter member of the Big Sky Conference. WSU has captured seven Big Sky titles and advanced to the FCS Playoffs eight times in school history. Weber State's list of legendary head coaches includes Sark Arslanian, Mike Price, Dave Arslanian and Ron McBride.

The 'Cats have had 51 players earn All-American honors and have had 37 players drafted in the NFL. Former WSU quarterback Jamie Martin won the 1991 Walter Payton Trophy and then had a long career in the NFL. Several other Wildcats have also played in the NFL, including Paul McQuistan who won a Super Bowl ring in 2015 with the Seattle Seahawks.

Steve Klauke, a three-time Utah Sportscaster of the Year, is in his fifth season as voice of the Wildcats and will call all football and men's basketball game for the Wildcats. Klauke is also the voice of the Salt Lake Bees, which he has done for the last 25 years.

Klauke will be joined on football broadcasts again this season by former WSU head coach and athletic director **Jerry Graybeal**. Graybeal was the head coach at Weber State from 1998-04 and served as athletic director from 2005-09.

WILDCATS EARN NUMBER 3 SEED IN FCS PLAYOFFS

Weber State finished the regular season with a 38-10 win over Idaho State, that clinched the third-straight Big Sky title and a 9-3 overall record. The Wildcats earned the Big Sky's automatic bid to the FCS Playoffs and earned the No. 3 seed, the second-straight season as a top three seed.

WSU had a bye in the first round before heading into Saturday's game against Kennesaw State, who defeated Wofford in the first round.

WEBER STATE FCS PLAYOFF HISTORY

Weber State is making its eighth trip to the NCAA FCS Playoffs and is competing in the playoffs for the fourth consecutive season, a school record. The Wildcats have advanced to the quarterfinals in each of the past two seasons. This is the fifth time competing in the second round and the second-straight year earning a bye into the second round.

This is also the third-straight season for WSU to host a playoff game at Stewart Stadium. The Wildcats never hosted a playoff game before the 2017 season.

WEBER STATE WINS THIRD-STRAIGHT BIG SKY TITLE

With the win over Idaho State, Weber State finished the Big Sky season with a 7-1 record for the third-straight season. The Wildcats won their seventh all-time and third-straight Big Sky Conference Championship.

14 WILDCATS EARN ALL-CONFERENCE HONORS

Following the regular season, Weber State led the Big Sky with 14 selections to the all-conference teams. WSU had five named to the first team, five to the second team and four to the third team.

Senior defensive end Jonah Williams was named the Co-Big Sky Defensive Player of the Year. Joining Williams on the first-team are sophomore running back Josh Davis, junior offensive lineman Ty Whitworth, junior defensive tackle Jared Schiess and junior fullback Clay Moss. It's the second-straight first-team honors for Davis and Whitworth and the first all-conference honors for Schiess and Moss.

Five Wildcats earned second-team honors, senior defensive end Adam Rodriguez, senior linebacker Austin Tesch, senior punter Doug Lloyd, junior kicker Trey Tuttle and red shirt freshman cornerback Eddie Heckard.

Junior running back Kevin Smith Jr., junior center Ben Bos, sophomore defensive end George Tarlas and junior safety Preston Smith all earned third-team All-Big Sky honors.

JONAH WILLIAMS NAMED BIG SKY CO-DEFENSIVE MVP



Senior Jonah Williams became just the fifth Wildcat in history to earn Defensive Player of the Year honors. Williams has started every game for the Wildcats at defensive end and is fifth in the Big Sky in sacks with 6.5. He is also second on the Wildcat team and 15th in the league in tackles for loss with nine.

The Meridian, Idaho native has played in 51 career games at Weber State. He has 14 career sacks and 26 tackles for loss.

JOSH DAVIS MOVES INTO CAREER RUSHING TOP 5

Wildcat sophomore running back Josh Davis moved into the top five in Weber State career rushing yardage. Davis now has 2,377 career yards and 19 touchdowns in just 25 career games to rank fifth in school history. Davis is fourth in the Big Sky this season in rushing at 84.6 yards per game. He surpassed 1,000 rushing yards for the second-straight season in the win over Idaho State and has 1,015 yards and 10 rushing touchdowns this season. He is the fifth Wildcat ever rush for over 1,000 rushing yards in two seasons.



The Sandy, Utah native has earned first-team All-Big Sky honors in each of his first two seasons and won the Jerry Rice award last year as the National Freshman of the Year.

HOME SWEET HOME

The Wildcats are back home for another game at Stewart Stadium. WSU finished the regular season undefeated at home for the second-straight year and just the fourth time in school history. Weber State is 6-0 at home for just the third-time ever.

The 'Cats have won 15 of the last 16, and 18 of the last 20 games at Stewart Stadium.

NATIONAL RANKINGS

The Wildcats rank near the top in the nation in several categories. Weber State is fourth in the country in third down conversion defense, allowing opponents to convert on just 30 percent of third downs.

WSU is also sixth in the country in net punting, sixth in time of possession, and seventh in turnover margin at +11.

Weber State ranks ninth in the nation in rushing defense at 107.3 yards per game, and this week faces the nation's top rushing team that is averaging 346.8 yards per game.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

The Big Sky Conference has four of the top six teams in the FCS Playoffs this season. Weber State is the number three seed, followed by Sacramento State, Montana State and Montana. All four schools will be home this Saturday.

30 IS THE MAGIC NUMBER

Weber State is 7-0 this season and 27-3 under coach Hill when scoring 30 or more points in a game. Conversely, the Wildcats are 2-3 this year and 18-26 under coach Hill when scoring less than 30 in a game.

Defensively, the Wildcats are 8-2 when this season and 41-10 under coach Hill when holding an opponent under 30 points and are 1-1 this season and 4-19 under Hill when allowing an opponent to score 30 points or more in a game.

SCORING TRENDS

The Wildcats are also 9-0 this season when scoring first in a game and 0-2 when the opponent scores first. Weber State is outscoring its opponents 80-47 in the first quarter and 108-82 in the second quarter this season.

WSU is also 7-1 this year and 35-7 under Hill when leading at halftime but is 1-2 this season and 6-21 under Hill when trailing at halftime.

TURNOVERS

Both teams this week are tied for seventh in the nation in turnover margin at +11. Weber State is 7-1 this season and 31-6 under coach Jay Hill when leading its opponents in turnover margin. The regular season finale against Idaho State was the first game of the season neither team did not have a turnover.

TEAM CAPTAINS

Six players are serving as team captains, as voted by their teammates. Junior quarterback Jake Constantine, senior defensive end Adam Rodriguez, junior wide receiver/returner Rashid Shaheed, senior linebacker Auston Tesch, junior kicker Trey Tuttle and senior defensive lineman Jonah Williams will serve as the team captains for the Wildcats throughout the season.

QUICK HITS

This is the third-straight year Weber State is playing in December, something that happened just twice in school history prior to 2017...WSU junior defensive tackle Jared Schiess was named to the Big Sky Football Community Service Team...One athlete from each school was recognized for their time in helping others and making an impact on their campus and community and were nominated by their head coaches...WSU had a season-high five sacks against Idaho State and has had at least one sack in every game and has had two or more sacks in 10 of the 12 games...Senior Adam Rodriguez is now tied for sixth in Weber State history with 17 career sacks...Junior kick returner and wide receiver Rashid Shaheed missed the Idaho State game with an mcl injury and sophomore tight end Justin Malone is out with a knee injury.

100TH ANNIVERSARY OF FOOTBALL AT WEBER STATE

This year marks the 100th anniversary of football at Weber State University. The first football team was fielded in 1919, when the school was known as Weber Normal College. Weber's first game was played on Oct. 8, 1919, a 20-0 loss to Box Elder High School in Brigham City. The first win was on Oct. 31, 1919, a 6-0 win over Davis High School in Ogden.

Over the last 100 years, thousands of players have played football for the Wildcats. Weber State became a junior college in 1933, then became a four-year school in 1962. In 1963, the Wildcats became a charter member of the Big Sky Conference, joining Idaho, Idaho State, Montana, and Montana State as football playing schools.

The Wildcats have captured six Big Sky Conference titles, including winning back-to-back titles in 2017 and 2018. Weber State has had 38 players drafted in the NFL Draft and 62 players have earned All-America honors. Many coaches have come through Weber State before going on to careers in the NFL. Wildcat quarterback Jamie Martin won the Walter Payton Award in 1991 as the nation's top player and WSU running back Josh Davis won the Jerry Rice Award as the National Freshman of the Year in 2018.

This year is also the 150th anniversary of college football which will be celebrated all season by schools across the country.

LOOKING AHEAD

The winner of Saturday's game will take on the winner of No. 6 seed Montana and Southeastern Louisiana in the quarterfinals, which will be played Dec. 13 or 14. If Weber State wins Saturday, the Wildcats would be home for the quarterfinals.

FCS PLAYOFFS SECOND ROUND - VS. KENNESAW STATE

ABOUT KENNESAW STATE



Kennesaw State enters Saturday's game with an 11-2 overall record and is ranked ninth in the nation in the AFCA coaches poll and 15th in the STATS poll. The Owls finished second in the Big South Conference with a 5-1 record. KSU is 6-1 on the road this season and has won 10 straight true road games against FCS opponents.

Kennesaw State has advanced to the quarterfinals of the FCS Playoffs in each of the last two seasons. The Owls were 12-2 in 2017 and 11-2 last season. They lost to South Dakota State in the quarterfinals last year and finished the season ranked fifth in the country. Kennesaw State is 4-2 all-time in the FCS Playoffs and has won at least one game in three straight seasons.

The Owls lead the nation in rushing offense, averaging 346.8 rushing yards per game, and have a national best 57 rushing touchdowns. Kennesaw State is third nationally in sacks allowed (5), fourth in total defense (278.1), fifth in scoring average (39.2), seventh in turnover margin (+11), and ninth in scoring defense (18.2).

Junior linebacker Bryson Armstrong was named the Big South Co-Defensive Player of the Year. He was joined on the all-conference first team by defensive lineman Desmond Johnson Jr., and offensive linemen Jake Lassiter and Chris Dye.

Kennesaw State is in just its fifth season of football after starting the program in 2015.

HEAD COACH BRIAN BOHANNON

Kennesaw State is coached by Brian Bohannon who is fifth season as head coach of the Owls. He enters Saturday's game with a 48-14 overall record. He is a two-time Big South Coach of the Year and was the National Coach of the Year in 2017. He is the first head coach in Kennesaw State history and has led the Owls to at least 11 wins in each of the last three seasons.

SERIES HISTORY

This is the first ever meeting between Weber State and Kennesaw State. It's also WSU's first ever game against a school from the Big South Conference. This is just the second game ever for Kennesaw State against a Big Sky opponent. The Owls traveled to Bozeman in November 2015 and beat Montana State 16-14.

Jay Hill is in his sixth season as the head coach at Weber State. In addition to his duties as head coach, Hill is Hill's third season also serving as the defensive coordinator for the Wildcats.

In his six years with the Wildcats, Hill has transformed the Weber State program and has led Weber State to four-straight FCS Playoff appearances, three-straight Big Sky titles and back-to-back 10-win seasons, and the team has been ranked as high as third in the nation, all WSU school records.

In his six seasons Hill has also coached 12 players to All-America honors at Weber State. The Wildcats have also earned 84 Big Sky All-Conference honors and 45 Wildcats Academic All-Big Sky honors under Hill's leadership.

In 2018, Weber State had another record-setting seasons as the Wildcats finished 10-3 in conference play, winning 10 games in back-to-back seasons for the first time ever. Weber State also repeated as Big Sky champions with a 7-1 conference record for the first time ever. The Wildcats earned their first ever seed in the FCS Playoffs as they earned the No. 2 seed and advanced to the quarterfinals for the second-straight season. Weber State was ranked as high as third in the nation, the highest ranking ever, and finished the year ranked sixth in the country. The Wildcats also had 19 players that earned All-Big Sky honors, including a school-record 13 players named to the first time.

In 2017, Hill was named the Utah Coach of the Year as part of the Governor's State of Sport Awards after he guided Weber State to its best season in school history. The Wildcats won the Big Sky Conference title, won a school-record 11 games, won two games in the FCS Playoffs and were ranked in the top five in the nation

Hill, 44, was named the 11th head coach in Weber State football history in December 2013. Hill was a long-time assistant coach at the University of Utah, and came to WSU with a reputation as one of the top recruiters in the West. He spent 13 years (2001-13) at Utah, including the last nine seasons as a full-time assistant coach under Kyle Whittingham. Prior to that, he spent four years as a graduate assistant and administrative assistant with the Utes under legendary coaches Ron McBride and Urban Meyer.

The Lehi, Utah native played college football at Ricks Junior College, where he earned junior college All-American honors at cornerback. He went on to play two seasons (1998-99) at Utah under Ron McBride. Hill earned a bachelor's degree in Spanish in 2000 from Utah and earned his master's degree in ESS/Sports Psychology in 2005.

He and his wife Sara have four children: Ashtyn, Alayna, Jacob and Allie.

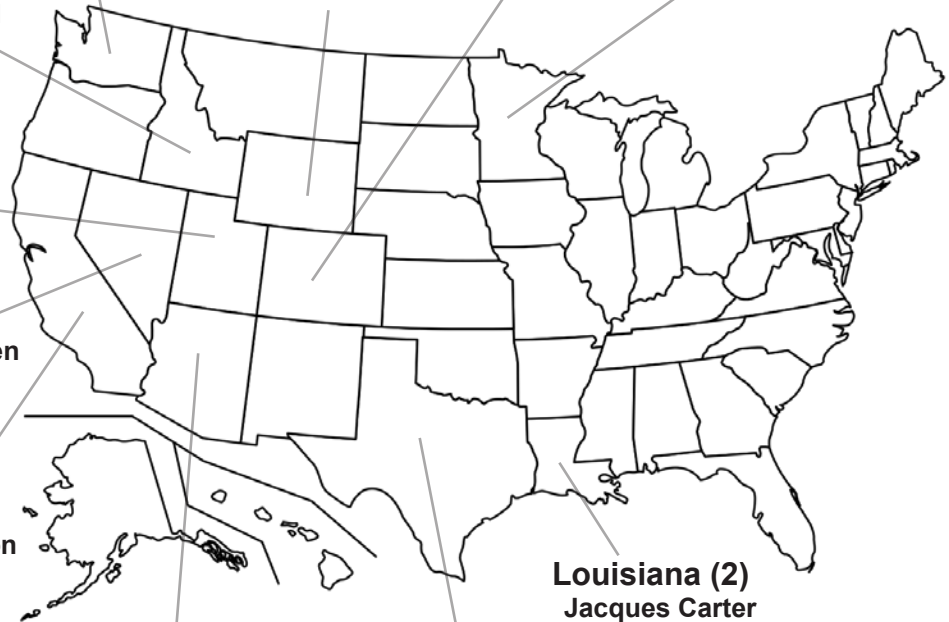
