### **TODAY'S GAME**

- ▶ Despite there being another week to the regular season, today's game is the defacto Big South Championship game as
- the winner of today's matchup will earn the league's automatic qualifier to the 2021 NCAA FCS Championship.

  Both teams are coming into today's game off of decisive conference victories in their last outings. Monmouth blew open a close halftime game with Gardner-Webb while KSU was in complete control by halftime of their game against Robert Morris.
- Today's game will feature the nation's second ranked rushing attack in Kennesaw State (294.8) against the sixth best rushing defense in Monmouth who is allowing 56 yards per game. Monmouth hasn't allowed more than 86 yards on the ground in its two games while the Owls have run for more than 300 yards in three of their four contests.
- The Hawks finally broke back into the top-25 polls after dropping out due to missing games when opponents had to cancel due to CV-19. Monmouth ranks 20th in the STATS Perform Poll, 22nd in the AFCA Coaches' Poll and 14th in the Athlon Sports Poll.
- The game will air on ESPN+with Eddie Occhipinti (pxp) and Emory Hunt (analyst) on the call.

### **INSIDE THE MONMOUTH-KENNESAW STATE SERIES**

- Today's game marks the sixth time that Kennesaw and Monmouth have met, with KSU winning four of the five previous matchups.
- Monmouth defeated the fouth-ranked Kennesaw Owls on the road last season, sprinting out to a 31-7 lead on Tymere Berry's pick six with one minute left in the half. The Hawks would scored two more to take a 45-7 lead before KSU scored on a pair of 50+ yard plays.
- The last time the Owls visited Kessler Stadium, the Hawks held a 14-7 lead in the second quarter but KSU scored 44 unanswered points including pitching a shutout in the second half to win its second Big South title.
- The teams first met in 2015 down at Kennesaw. The Hawks struck first on a 12 yard Darren Ambush TD but KSU held Monmouth out of the endzone for the next 46+ minutes building a 23-7 lead in the process. KSU had 341 yards rushing with two 100+ yard rushers on the day.

### **JUWON FARRI EARNS BACK TO BACK WEEKLY AWARDS**

Monmouth redshirt sophomore Juwon Farri broke his own personal record he set last week by reaching the endzone four times on the ground in Monmouth's 48-19 win over Gardner-Webb. He finished with his second consecutive 100-yard game, rushing for 124 yards on 24 carries. Not only did Farri averaged 5.2 yards per carry but he did not have a negative rush against the Runnin' Bulldogs. Farri scored on a short run of two yards and a pair of one yard runs out of the wildcat before breaking into the open field for a 20 yard scoring jaunt in the fourth quarter. Farri, who has seven touchdowns in two games this season, won Offensive Player of the Week last week as well. He was also named STATS Perform National Player of the Week runner up.

#### THIS WEEK'S GAME CAPTAINS

Due to the shortened Spring season, Monmouth will not have traditional season long captains, instead will have game by game. Today's game captains for the Hawks are seniors **Eddie Hahn**, **Kahari Scarlett**, **Lonnie Moore** and **Mahmoud Shabana**.

### HAWKS SELECTED FIRST IN PRESEASON POLL

Monmouth University was selected to finish first, for the first time since joining the Big South in the 2020-21 Big South Preseason Poll. The Hawks edged out Kennesaw State by one point, however garnered six of a possible 10 first place votes. Hampton, Campbell and North Alabama were not included in the poll due to choosing to opt out in the Spring.

### MONMOUTH AGAINST THE BIG SOUTH

- Since starting up Big South league play in 2014, Monmouth owns an 20-14 conference record, however is 16-2 since 2017.
- The Hawks own a 6-1 record against Gardner-Webb, 2-0 against Campbell, 4-1 against CSU and 1-4 vs Kennesaw State. The Hawks are also 1-0 against Hampton (3-0 overall) in conference competition. MU is 1-0 against North Alabama as well.
- The Hawks won their first Big South Title in 2019 going undefeated for the first time since joining the league.
- MU was 0-3 against members of the Big South prior to joining the league, including dropping a home and home series with Coastal Carolina and a non-conference tilt with the Flames. The Hawks were also 4-2 against PC.
- With the win over Campbell in 2019, Monmouth won four consecutive Big South games to start Big South play for the first time in school history (2017).

### DID YOU KNOW?

The winner of the Monmouth vs Kennesaw State football game has decided the Big South Champion and earned the league's automatic bid to the NCAA FCS Playoffs in each of the last four seasons, including wins by KSU in 2017 and 2018 and Monmouth in 2019. The winner of today's game will once again be Big South Champions.



### HEAD COACH BRIAN BOHANNON



Brian Bohannon was introduced as the first head coach in Kennesaw State history in March of 2013. In Six years he has turned a brand new program in a nationally-ranked, championship winning team with a 52-15 record. A native of Griffin, Ga., Bohannon has 18 seasons of coaching experience at the FBS and FCS levels, all of which have come while

working with Georgia Tech head coach Paul Johnson, Most recently Bohannon served as quarterbacks/B backs coach at Georgia Tech under Johnson. He has also coached at Navy and Georgia Southern. A four-year letter winner and standout as a wide receiver at Georgia, Bohannon started his coaching career at West Georgia before earning his first full-time position at Gardner-Webb (N.C.) as wide receivers coach in 1996.

# THE LAST MEETING

# Mormorth 45, Kennesaw State. 21

KENNESAW, GA - The Monmouth University football team (7-2, 4-0 Big South) scored 42 unanswered points to cruise to a 45-21 win over No. 4/5 Kennesaw State (7-2, 2-1 Big South), the highest ranked team the Hawks have ever defeated.

It was Monmouth's first win over Kennesaw State, who came into the game ranked first in the NCAA in total defense (259.0 ypg), and third in both scoring offense (41.4 ppg) and scoring defense (14.3 ppg). Monmouth's defense allowed just 292 yards on the ground while the offense churned out 517 yards including 332 through the air.
The Hawks fell behind 7-3 in the first quarter before fifth-year senior

Kenji Bahar led a 42-point onslaught, that including a pair of Devell Jones touchdowns and a Pete Guerriero score on the ground. Bahar finished 20-of-27 passing for 332 yards and a touchdown pass, while adding 92 vards rushing.

It is the worst home loss in Kennesaw State's history and was the first time in 13 games the Owls were handed a conference loss. The loss was also KSU's first regular season setback at home since Oct. 15, 2016 snapping a streak of 17 consecutive wins.

After four consecutive three and out possessions started the game, the Hawks struck first with a 23-yard Matt Mosquera field goal. The Owls answered quickly, scoring a touchdown on a two-yard Tommy Bryant touchdown run to take a 7-3 lead.

Monmouth retook the lead on its next drive on a two-yard Devell Jones touchdown run. That drive took just 2:38, going 68 yards on nine plays. After another forced three and out by the MU defense, the Hawks went up 17-7 on an eight-yard Jones touchdown run with 9:15 to play in the second quarter.

Guerriero went untouched up the middle for the Hawks' fourth score of the first half and Monmouth led 24-7 with 2:17 to play. Senior Tymere Berry closed out the first 30 minutes of play with a 41-yard interception return, the first Monmouth INT for a touchdown this season.

The Hawks scored quickly in the second half with Bahar hitting Zach Tredway for a 92-yard touchdown pass and then taking off up the middle untouched for a 65-yard touchdown run. The Owls scored their first points since the first half on a 60-yard halfback pass with Bronson Rechsteiner connecting with Shaq Terry. With four minutes remaining and most of the Monmouth starters resting, Bryant ran for 50 yards to finish the scoring 45-21. The 24-point halftime deficit was the largest KSU faced all season

- Tredway finished with a career-high 162 yards on seven receptions
- Senior wideout Brandon Batts had five receptions for 92 yards including a 55-yard bomb
- Monmouth outgained the Owls 290-140 in the first half, including allowing just 85 yards rushing
- Berry's interception return for a touchdown was the first by a Hawk since Gerron Perndarvis' against Charleston Southern in 2017
- Da'Quan Grimes became the seventh current Hawk to eclipse the 100-tackle plateau, finishing with seven tackles to lead the Hawks
- Bahar ran for a career-high 92 yards on six rushes

### **NOTES ON THE GARDNER-WEBB GAME**

- Monmouth improved to 6-1 all-time against Gardner-Webb with last week's win, including a 3-1 record in Boiling Springs. The Hawks handed the Runnin' Bulldogs their first loss of the 2021 season
- For the second straight game Monmouth held its opponent to under 100-yards rushing, this time GWU ending with 84 and an average of 2.3 yards per rush
- Monmouth had 407 yards of total offense compared to 228 for GWU
- The Hawks are now +5 in turnover margin this season and have recorded nine sacks in two games. MU had two fumble recoveries and an interception and sacked GWU's QB four times
- Monmouth was just 1-of-12 on third down but was 3-of-4 on fourth down with two touchdowns
- The MU offensive line allowed just one negative play on offense
- Tony Muskett started his second career game, throwing for 155 yards and two touchdowns, one to Lonnie Moore IV and one to Terrance Greene Jr.
- Monmouth's 48 points were the second most scored in the series, with the Hawks averaging 48.5 points in the last four meetings, all Hawk victories.
- The Hawk defense pitched a second half shutout against Gardner-Webb and now has allowed just seven points after halftime this season
- MU welcomed the return of Moore, who led the team in all-purpose yards with 130 and receiving yards with 83 on six receptions

#### **OFFENSIVE NOTES**

- **Juwon Farri** won back to back offensive player of the week honors after rushing for 124 yards on 24 carries with a career-high four touchdowns
- Junior **Romeo Holden** recorded his first 100-yard game and his first collegiate touchdown after averaging an impressive 10.2 yards per rush
- Monmouth had two runners go over 100 yards in the same game for the first time since 2018, also against GWU when Farri and Pete Guerriero achieved it
- Monmouth's offense is scoring **41.5 points per game** through its first two games which is fourth in the FCS and first in the Big South
- While the offensive line has rotated through seven players consistantly, the five starters AJ Farris, Justin Szuba, Mo Shabana, Manny Christian and Brian Syracuse have combined for 80 career starts and 139 career games between them.
- That offensive line has allowed three sacks in 59 passing attempts
- Moore moved into fifth all-time in receptions with 124 with MU great Miles Austin III ahead of him in fourth with 150 career catches
- Greene Jr currently ranks 13th all-time in career receptions with 90 through two-plus seasons

### **DEFENSIVE NOTES**

- Eddie Morales III recorded his first sack and forced fumble of his career in the first quarter when he blitzed off the edge and blindsided the GWU QB
- Monmouth ranks 1st in the FCS in turnover margin at +2.5 per game
- Senior **Kahari Scarlett** led the Hawks with 1.5 sacks and was credited with three QB hurries. Scarlett has eight career sacks and 15.5 TFLs
- Safety **Jason Antwi**, who is seeing significant playing time for the first time had a career-high five tackles and a pass break up against GWU
- Seniors **Da'Quan Grimes** (12) and **Anthony Budd** (11) had season-highs in tackles against the Runnin' Bulldogs
- Budd recorded his second interception in as many games, giving him eight in his career which ranks tied for sixth with **Joe Johnson, Aaron Edwards** and **Mike Basile**
- Transfer LB **Eddie Hahn V** continued his torrid start for the Hawks with eight total tackles, half a sack, two for a loss, one breakup and a forced fumble. In the third quarter alone Hahn had two fourth down stops against GWU.

### **SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES**

- **Eddie Morales** had a 31 yard punt return last weekend, the longest since his 41 yard return against Gardner-Webb in 2019.
- Junior punter **Ryan Kost** beat his career-long punt of 55 yards with a 59 yard punt against Gardner-Webb. That punt was muffed by Gardner-Webb and recovered by **Tyler Delgado** deep in Bulldog territory.
- Freshman **Kaeon Torres** is now 11 for 12 in extra points after having his first attempt against Gardner-Webb blocked.
- Keep an eye on Moore IV who needs just a few returns to set the Monmouth record for kickoff return yards. He averages 23.0 yards per return in his career.
- Monmouth's second touchdown was setup after a dropped snap by GWU's punter forced him to scramble but wideout **Alex Bryant** hunted him down and tackled him on the four yard line

### MONMOUTH **EXTRA POINTS**

- Just two games into his second season, Juwon Farri moved into 13th in rushing yardage and is just 12 yards away from moving into 12th past Jim Varick.
- Eddie Morales III is averaging 2.5 passes defended a game in 2021, which is second in the nation and first in the league. Coming into '21 he had three passes defended.
- Monmouth is averaging 438.5 total offensive yards per game in 2021, which ranks the Hawks first in the Big South and 11th among FCS teams.
- ▶ Moore and Greene had two of the best seasons in history in 2019, both landing in the top-10 in receptions and yardage.
- With seven touchdowns in two games Farri is now ranked 10th all-time in rushing touchdowns with 15 in 13 career games.
- Monmouth converted just one third down opportunity last week, going 1-for-12 against Gardner-Webb. The Hawks entered the game ranked 22nd in the country conveting 47% of third down chances.
- After five players recorded interceptions for the Hawks in 2019, three of Monmouth's four starters in the defensive backfield recorded interceptions against CSU.
- ► Senior safety **Anthony Budd's** five interceptions in 2019 tied for the most alltime in a single season. Of the five players who have recorded five interceptions, two of them have come in the last two seasons under DB coach Lewis Walker.
- Monmouth ranks fourth in the FCS out of 96 teams with just seven total penalties in two games for an average of 3.5 per game. The Hawks are fifth in penalty yardage with 71 yards of penalties in 2021.
- Monmouth cornerback Justin Terry recently moved into fourth with 29 passes defended. Terry has 26 pass breakups and three interceptions in 36 career games for the Blue & White.

# Monmouth 48, Cardner-Webb 19

### Apr. 3, 2021 • Spangler Stadium • Boiling Springs, NC

**BOILING SPRINGS, NC-** Monmouth University's (2-0, 2-0 Big South) defense shut out Gardner-Webb (2-1, 0-1 Big South) in the second half while the Hawks piled up 28 points to break open a close game en route to a 48-19 win on Saturday.

The Hawks allowed just 52 yards in the second half while redshirt sophomore running back Juwon Farri ran for a career-high four touchdowns and 124 yards rushing to pace the Monmouth offense. Freshman Tony Muskett threw a pair of touchdown passes for the second consecutive week and reserve running back Romeo Holden averaged 10.2 yards per carry with his first 100-yard performance and first career touchdown.

Defensively, the Hawks forced a trio of turnovers for the second straight week including a pair of fumble recoveries and an Anthony Budd interception. Senior DaQuan Grimes' 12 tackles paced the defense, which held GWU to 1-of-7 on fourth down and 3-of-16 on third down. Budd finished with 11 tackles while the Monmouth defense had four sacks and eight tackles for a loss.

Monmouth opened up a 20-3 lead after capitalizing on early miscues by Gardner-Webb. The Bulldogs rallied late in the first half, scoring 16 points in a 1:50 span, including a field goal as time expired to cut Monmouth's halftime lead to 20-19. The second half belonged to the Hawks, as Eddie Hahn made a pair of third-quarter fourth-down stops to give the MU offense a short field. Muskett hit Lonnie Moore in the corner of the endzone for the first score of the second half with Farri scoring twice and Holden rumbling in from 28 yards in the fourth.

#### **NOTES**

- It was the first time since the 2018 meeting with Gardner-Webb that Monmouth had two backs over 100-yards, in that game Farri and Pete Guerriero eclipsed the 100-yard mark
- Farri's four rushing touchdowns were the most since Julian Hayes scored four times against Saint Francis (PA) on November 5, 2011
- Eddie Morales III recorded his first sack and forced fumble of his career in the first quarter when he blitzed off the edge and blindsided the GWU signal caller
- Monmouth's second touchdown was setup after a dropped snap by GWU's punter forced him to scramble but Alex Bryant hunted him down and tackled him on the four yard line
- Included in GWU's 16 points in 1:50 was a 92 yard punt return for a touchdown by Runnin' Bulldog Devron Harper
- For just the second time in the last 16 games Monmouth did not have an advantage in time of possession, with GWU earning a 30:12 to 29:48 advantage
- Senior Kahari Scarlett led the Hawks with 1.5 sacks and was credited with three QB hurries
- It was Farri's eighth 100-yard rushing game, and now has 15 career rushing touchdowns, which is 10th all-time at Monmouth. He has appeared in 13 total games for the Blue & White
- Jason Antwi had a career-high five tackles and a pass breakup

## **HEAD COACH KEVIN CALLAHAN**



The only head coach in the history of football at Monmouth, Kevin Callahan has developed a winning tradition in West Long Branch. Callahan, whose 165 wins is 6th among active coaches at the FCS level, has guided a once fledgling nonscholarship program to a top-12 national ranking and NCAA playoff berths. He is one of three FCS coaches with 150+ wins all at one institution and his 27 years as a head coach is the sixth most among active coaches. In 2019 he was named

AFCA Region II Coach of the Year while finishing fourth in the Eddie Robinson Award voting, awarded to the nation's top FCS Coach.

Beginning his 28th season at the helm of the Hawks, Callahan has amassed a 163-124 record while his teams have captured six conference titles with a pair of playoff appearances. Along the way, Monmouth has been ranked among the top 20 in total offense on three occasions and in total defense five times. Meanwhile, over 150 players have earned conference recognition, while numerous Hawks have earned regional and national honors. Regarded as an outstanding coach by his peers, Callahan served as the President of the FCS Football Coaches Committee in 2007-08 and served a 10-year term as a member of the committee. Under his watch, 12 former Hawks have earned spots on NFL rosters, including Super Bowl Champion Chris Hogan and Miles Austin who was an All-Pro wide receiver for the Dallas Cowboys.

Academically, Callahan's squads have consistently performed at a high level. Thirteen players have been named to the prestigious FCS ADA Academic All-Star team (average of 55 FCS players selected per season) a total 16 times. Monmouth has had at least one representative on the Capital One Academic All-District Team in 16 of the last 18 seasons, with Justin Rosato and Justin Szuba earning Academic All-American honors. Monmouth has been ranked either first or second among Big South schools in the NCAA's Academic Progress Rate (APR) in each of the last three seasons that data has been available.

Monmouth football reached new heights in 2019, winning its first Big South Championship and first playoff game, en route to a No. 12 final ranking while setting a plethora of team and individual records. The Hawks set records for overall wins with 11, home wins (7) and put together a program record nine-game winning streak. Monmouth had a program-best 17 All-Big South selections led by fifth-year senior quarterback Kenji Bahar, who was also the Big South Offensive Player of the Year. Seven different Hawks took home All-American honors including running back Pete Guerriero who led the NCAA in rushing en route to consensus All-American status. Guerriero, who broke the Monmouth rushing and all-purpose yard records became Monmouth's first Walter Payton Award Finalist, finishing in third place. Callahan earned his first Big South Coach of the Year honor as voted on by his peers.

In 2018 Monmouth's offense was one of the top in all of the FCS setting over 15 individual and team records. The Hawks completed their second consecutive eight-win season while finishing second in the Big South. A Monmouth record 12 Hawks earned spots on the All-Big South Team while freshman running back Juwon Farri earned Big South Offensive Freshman of the Year and finished fifth in the Jerry Rice Award voting. Wideout Reggie White Jr. set almost every single-season and career receiving mark and his efforts were rewarded with numerous All-America nods

and a free agent contract with the New York Giants.

The Hawks took another huge step in 2017, opening the brand new 16 million Kessler Stadium, earning its first national ranking and its first NCAA Playoff berth. Callahan guided the Hawks to a 9-3 overall record, including a 4-1 mark in the Big South, and faced Northern Iowa in the NCAA First Round. In addition to going 5-0 at home, the Hawks strung together a sevengame win streak heading into the final game of the regular season.

Prior to accepting the head coaching position at Monmouth in August of 1992, Callahan served as assistant coach at Colgate University for eight seasons. While with the Raiders, Callahan served as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator, while tutoring the linebackers Callahan and secondary. groomed his defensive coordinating skills at Wagner College from 1981 to 1983. In 1980, Callahan served as an assistant coach prior to accepting the head coaching position at Monmouth in August of 1992, Callahan served as assistant coach at Colgate University for eight seasons. While with the Raiders, Callahan served as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator, while the linebackers tutoring secondary. Callahan groomed his defensive coordinating skills at Wagner College from 1981 to 1983. In 1980, Callahan served as an assistant coach under Frank Maloney at Syracuse University. He served as the assistant offensive backfield coach for the Orangemen.

A native of Elmira, N.Y., Callahan began his coaching career as a graduate assistant for three seasons at the University of Albany from 1977 to 1979. Callahan was

a two-year standout defensive back at the University of Rochester. He earned a bachelor's degree in history from Rochester in 1977.

Callahan and his wife, Ann Marie, reside in Spring Lake Heights. They have two children, Kevin Jr. and Julia. His son Kevin Jr, a five-year veteran of collegiate coaching, recently joined the Hawk coaching staff mentoring the wideouts.

Monmouth University plays all of its home football and lacrosse games at Kessler Stadium on the school's beautiful 156-acre campus in West Long Branch, New Jersey. On September 2, 2017, the Hawks celebrated the start of the 25th year of football by cutting the ribbon on the 16 million dollar Kessler Stadium. The Hawks went on to defeat Lafayette 31-12 in the first contest in the new stadium en route to going 5-0 at home, one of four times in school history MU has gone unbeaten at home. Monmouth dominated in those five wins, outscoring opponents 216-113 while racking up 43.2 points per game. In all, over 16,000 fans came out to watch the Hawks in their new home, including a sellout of 4,235 on homecoming against Liberty. The 2019 season saw the Hawks set a record for home wins while going ubeaten for the fourth time in history at 7-0. Included in those wins was the program's first ever NCAA Playoff win, a 44-27 victory over Holy Cross on November 30, 2019.

The facility expanded seating to over 4,200, stretching from endzone to endzone. It also features a ticket booth, restroom facilities, concession stands and storage. The third floor of the stadium houses the press box, coaches booths, radio and broadcast booths and a replay booth. The second floor features a full donor deck, where members of the Blue/White Club can enjoy the game as well as pre and post game events. It was announced in July of 2017 that Alumni John and Henni Kantor Kessler, class of 1969 and 1968, respectively, gave a generous seven-figure gift to ensure that the Kessler name continues to be synonymous with Monmouth Athletics. In the summer of 2014, the playing surface was refitted with a state-of-the-art artificial surface by the FieldTurf Corporation.

For the opening of the Monmouth Hawks' first football season in 1993, a 3,000-seat grandstand with press box was built. It was the Kessler's who stepped up to the plate in 1993, donating \$250,000 toward construction if the original facility. On September 25, 1993, the first-ever game was played at Kessler Field as the Hawks hosted Sacred Heart University. Although the facility officially seats 4,600 fans, a record crowd of 6,233

packed Kessler Field on Homecoming Weekend in 1993.

Behind the east endzone of Kessler Stadium sits Monmouth's 57 million dollar OceanFirst Bank Center, which houses the football locker room. Opening in the Fall of 2009, the buildings indoor arena and track provides a better training facility for the team's winter conditioning program as well as rehabilitation efforts. The building features meeting rooms that are large enough to accommodate the entire team but also areas small enough where individual positions can meet.

### FAMILIAR FACE IN THE BACKFIELD FOR THE HAWKS

While it is true that the Hawks will miss All-American speedster Pete Guerriero in the backfield as he suits up for the NFL's New York Jets these days, the Hawk running back stable is far from empty. Returning after missing 2019 is redshirt sophomore **Juwon Farri** who earned First Team All-Big South honors and Freshman of the Year honors in 2018 after leading the league in rushing. The ECAC Rookie of the Year compiled 1,024 rushing yards while starting just four games as a freshman. Other than his 13 carries for 111 yards in the season opener against Eastern Michigan, Farri didn't carry the ball more than eight times in five of Monmouth's first six games in 2018.

### FARRIS AND MOORE IV EARN PRESEASON ALL-AMERICAN NODS

Monmouth seniors AJ Farris and Lonnie Moore IV were named as Preseason All-Americans in the summer prior to the 2020 fall shutdown. Last season (2019) Monmouth claimed a program record seven Hawks earned All-American honors with four of those players returning. Moore was named preseason All-America kickoff returner while Farris, a senior center, was also honored by STATS Perform. Moore, who averaged 27.8 yards per kickoff return in 2019, was also named by HERO Sports on their preseason AA list.

#### **MUSKETT'S FIRST START BEST IN SCHOOL HISTORY**

True freshman Tony Muskett became the 16th quarterback to start for the Hawks in the 28 years of the program. Muskett was the third true freshman to start a game at quarterback for Monmouth and the first since Doug Rossback in 1993 (the other was Rich Barglowski in 1993). He is just the sixth quarterback to throw at least one touchdown and no interceptions in his first career start with 297 yards the most in history for a first game starter. He is only one of five quarterbacks have won their debut for the Blue & White.
