TOP STORYLINES

• Kennesaw State is looking to win its first season opener since 2015, the first game in program history when the Owls beat ETSU, 56-16.

• In its young infancy as a program, KSU hasn't often faced opponents from its home state of Georgia, however, it has dropped just one game, a 24-20 battle at Georgia State last season.

• The Owls are 5-1 all time against teams from the Peach State.

• At 102 miles separating the two schools, Point is the farthest school in Georgia that the Owls have played.

• Kennesaw State enters the 2019 season looking to become the first team in Big South history to win three straight outright conference championships.

• Last season, the Owls became the third Big South member to win consecutive conference championships with an undefeated record, posting back-to-back 5-0 league records.

• Dating back to Week 2 of the 2017 season, KSU has won 23 of its last 26 games, including going 5-2 against ranked teams.

• The Owls have not lost a regular season home contest since Oct. 15, 2016, winning 13 consecutive games.

• KSU's 18 consecutive regular season FCS wins are the most in Big South Conference history. The Owls have also won their last nine regular season non-conference FCS

contests, which is the third-longest streak in league history.

• The Owls return just 29.3 percent of their scoring from a year ago and return just one starter on offense, the fewest of any team in the Big South.

• Kennesaw State has finished in the top three nationally in rushing offense each of the last three years, including a program-best and Big South record 352.9 yards per game last season.

• Excluding the inaugural class of the "OG's" that featured 74 freshmen, the 2019 roster features the most freshmen that have been on a Kennesaw State roster with 48.

After becoming the first head football coach in Kennesaw State University history, Brian Bohannon has taken the Owls to heights never seen by a start-up football program.

In just four short years, Bohannon has led the Owls to a 37-12 record, back-to-back Big South Conference championships and consecutive appearances in the quarterfinals of the FCS Playoffs. After graduating the inaugural signing class in 2018, Bohannon has a new challenge ahead as the Owls go for an outright three-peat conference championship in 2019, something never done in the history of the league.

After putting the world on notice in 2017 with a 12-2 season, the outright Big South Conference title and two FCS Playoffs victories, the Owls somehow outdid themselves during the 2018 campaign. Ranked No. 2 in the nation for much of the year, KSU earned the No. 4 overall seed in the playoffs and took an 11-game winning streak to a second consecutive quarterfinal appearance where they held the third-longest home streak in the nation that dated back over two calendar years.

While the Owls have dominated on the field, Bohannon continues to collect accolades, earning the AFCA FCS National Coach of the Year following the 2017 season and earned AFCA District Coach of the Year after the 2018 campaign to go along with back-to-back Big South Conference Coach of the Year honors.

Bohannon, 47, put Kennesaw State on the map in 2017 when he led the Owls to a 12-2 season and an outright Big South Championship after finishing conference play undefeated at 5-0. Holding the country's top rushing offense, the Owls would make their first postseason berth in stellar fashion, getting revenge from their season-opening loss to Samford by winning 28-17 to advance.

The Owls then upset No. 3 Jacksonville State in the second round by scoring 14 unanswered second-half points to win 17-7. KSU's historic run would falter in the quarterfinals in a tough 34-27 loss to No. 5 Sam Houston State, but not before solidifying a young Kennesaw State team as one of the nation's top programs, earning him 2017 Big South Coach of the Year and AFCA FCS National Coach of the Year honors.

After being named Kennesaw State's coach on March 24, 2013, it took Bohannon just two seasons to vie for a Big South Conference title and reach the Top 25 as the Owls finished their debut year 6-5 before posting an 8-3 mark in 2016.

A four-year letterwinner and standout wide receiver at Georgia, Bohannon started his coaching career at West Georgia before earning his first full-time position at Gardner-Webb (N.C.) as wide receivers coach in 1996.

Bohannon earned his bachelor's degree in general business from Georgia in 1993 and a master's in business education from West Georgia in 1996.

Residing in Woodstock, Ga., Bohannon is married to the former Melanie Cobb. The two have three children, sons Blake and Braden, and daughter Brooke Anna.

• The Owls were the only D1 defense in the state to allow fewer than 300 total yards per game in 2018. At 263.7, KSU ranked fourth among all FCS and FBS schools.

BEST IN BIG SOUTH

• In just four years of existence, Kennesaw State and head coach Brian Bohannon have three all-time playoff wins -- the second-most by both a league member and head coach. Former member Coastal Carolina and its head coach, Joe Moglia, own the record of four playoff victories.

• Bohannon is seventh in Big South history with 37 career coaching wins, and became the second-fastest Big South coach to win 35 games when he reached the benchmark with KSU's 51-14 Big South championship win over Monmouth on Nov. 10, 2018 - just his 46th career game on the sideline.

NEXT MAN UP

• Sophomore Nathan Robertson will look to handle the placekicking duties, replacing stalwart Justin Thompson. During his freshman campaign, he was 2-for-2 kicking field goals, while making all four of his PAT's. No stranger to the field, he recorded 82 kickoffs with 16 touchbacks last season.

STINGY GROUP

• The Owls' defense features eight returning starters from a unit that set the Big South conference record for points allowed per game last season (15.4).

• Kennesaw State returns 90.4 percent of its turnover production from a season ago and 80.7 percent of its pass break-ups.

• KSU returns four of its top five tacklers from a year ago, including Bryson Armstrong, the former Jerry Rice Award winner.

• Last season, the Owls became the first team in Big South history to limit five consecutive opponents to 13 points or less.

• KSU ended the 2018 campaign ranked No. 11 in the nation in third down defense with opponents converting just 28.9 percent of the time.

• The Kennesaw State defense experienced a coaching shakeup in the offseason. Head Coach Brian Bohannon tasked Blake Harrell with leading the squad as the defensive coordinator, while hiring position coaches Danny Verpaele (Safeties), Darius Stafford (Cornerbacks) and Rico Zackery (Defensive Ends).

TIME TO RELOAD

• The Owls return just one starter on the offensive side of the ball after losing the Walter Payton Award runner-up at quarterback, and NFL free agent signees at running back and wide receiver.

• The Owls return just 29.3 percent of their scoring from a year ago, the fewest of any team in the Big South.

• Junior running back Shaquil Terry is the only returning starter on offense after rushing for 576 yards on 78 carries and six total touchdowns in 2018.

• Kennesaw State finished the 2018 season as the No. 2 rushing attack in all of Division I FBS and FCS football, averaging 352.9 yards per game on the ground.

• The Owls had 10 one-play scoring drives last season and 14 scoring drives under 60 seconds.
