TOP STORYLINES

- Kennesaw State is back on the road for the third straight week this Saturday, traveling to the Show Me State for its first meeting against Missouri State.
- The Owls are 0-1 all-time against teams from the Missouri Valley Football Conference. The lone meeting came last year in the quarterfinals of the FCS Playoffs, falling to No. 2 South Dakota State 27-17 at Fifth Third Bank Stadium.
- After falling to Kent State 26-23 in overtime in week two, the Owls bounced back with an impressive 42-7 thumping of Alabama State last Saturday. The Owls are 7-0 in their last seven games following a loss, outscoring opponents 293-103 in those contests.
- · The Owls currently lead all Division I football teams (FBS & FCS) in rushing offense at 388.7 yards per game. Kennesaw State has finished in the top three nationally in rushing offense each of the last three years, including a program-best and Big South record 352.9 yards per game last season.
- Kennesaw State's 481 rushing yards against Alabama State are the most rushing yards in a game this season for an FCS program and the second-most in all of college football behind South Carolina's 493 yards on the ground against Charleston Southern.
- Kennesaw State is the only FCS program in the country to rank in the top five in total offense and total defense. The Owls rank No. 2 in the country in defense, surrendering just 222.7 yards per game, while ranking No. 5 on offense, gaining 516.3 yards per contest.

- Joel Parker had a career game last Saturday against Alabama State, recording 3.0 sacks and adding 6.0 tackles for loss. He is the only player in Division I football (FBS & FCS) this year with 3.0 sacks and 6.0 TFL's in a game. Parker leads all FCS freshmen with 7.0 tackles for loss and 4.0 sacks.
- KSU's 19 consecutive regular season FCS wins are the most in Big South Conference history. The Owls have also won their last 10 regular season non-conference FCS contests, which is the third-longest streak in league history.
- Dating back to Week 2 of the 2017 season, KSU has won 25 of its last 29 games, including going 5-2 against FCS ranked teams.

NOTING MISSOURI STATE

- Missouri State opened the year with backto-back losses, falling to Northern Arizona and Tulane.
- MSU was picked to finish 10th in the Missouri Valley Football Conference 2019 preseason poll.
- The Bears return 44 letterwinners and 13 total starters from last year's 4-7 squad.
- Through two games, the Bears are being outscored 95-29, including 58-12 in the first half.
- Quarterback Peyton Huslig has passed for 417 yards and three touchdowns in the first two games and completed 56.7 percent of his passes.
- Tyler Currie leads the wide receivers with eight catches for 122 yards and one score.
- McNeece Egbim and Matt McClellan lead the defense with 13 tackles each, while Tyler Lovelace is responsible for the only interception on the team.
- Donovan Daniels paces the running backs at 20.5 yards per game on the ground. The Bears are still in search of their first rushing score this year.

After becoming the first head football coach in Kennesaw State University history, Brian Bohannon has taken the Owls to heights never seen by a start-up football program.

In just four short years, Bohannon has led the Owls to a 37-12 record, back-to-back Big South Conference championships and consecutive appearances in the quarterfinals of the FCS Playoffs. After graduating the inaugural signing class in 2018, Bohannon has a new challenge ahead as the Owls go for an outright three-peat conference championship in 2019, something never done in the history of the league.

After putting the world on notice in 2017 with a 12-2 season, the outright Big South Conference title and two FCS Playoffs victories, the Owls somehow outdid themselves during the 2018 campaign. Ranked No. 2 in the nation for much of the year, KSU earned the No. 4 overall seed in the playoffs and took an 11-game winning streak to a second consecutive quarterfinal appearance where they held the third-longest home streak in the nation that dated back over two calendar years.

While the Owls have dominated on the field, Bohannon continues to collect accolades, earning the AFCA FCS National Coach of the Year following the 2017 season and earned AFCA District Coach of the Year after the 2018 campaign to go along with back-to-back Big South Conference Coach of the Year honors.

Bohannon, 47, put Kennesaw State on the map in 2017 when he led the Owls to a 12-2 season and an outright Big South Championship after finishing conference play undefeated at 5-0. Holding the country's top rushing offense, the Owls would make their first postseason berth in stellar fashion, getting revenge from their season-opening loss to Samford by winning 28-17 to advance.

The Owls then upset No. 3 Jacksonville State in the second round by scoring 14 unanswered second-half points to win 17-7. KSU's historic run would falter in the quarterfinals in a tough 34-27 loss to No. 5 Sam Houston State, but not before solidifying a young Kennesaw State team as one of the nation's top programs, earning him 2017 Big South Coach of the Year and AFCA FCS National Coach of the Year honors.

After being named Kennesaw State's coach on March 24, 2013, it took Bohannon just two seasons to vie for a Big South Conference title and reach the Top 25 as the Owls finished their debut year 6-5 before posting an 8-3 mark in 2016.

A four-year letterwinner and standout wide receiver at Georgia, Bohannon started his coaching career at West Georgia before earning his first full-time position at Gardner-Webb (N.C.) as wide receivers coach in 1996.

Bohannon earned his bachelor's degree in general business from Georgia in 1993 and a master's in business education from West Georgia in 1996.

Residing in Woodstock, Ga., Bohannon is married to the former Melanie Cobb. The two have three children, sons Blake and Braden, and daughter Brooke Anna.

- The Owls are the only D1 team in the state to rush for 300+ yards per game in each of the last three seasons.
- Kennesaw State and the University of Georgia are the only two D1 teams in the state to record 30+ victories in the last four years. UGA leads the way at 44, followed by KSU at 39.
- Kennesaw State has finished in the top three nationally in rushing offense each of the last three years, including a programbest and Big South record 352.9 yards per game last season.

BEST IN BIG SOUTH

- In just four years of existence, Kennesaw State and head coach Brian Bohannon have three all-time playoff wins -- the second-most by both a league member and head coach. Former member Coastal Carolina and its head coach, Joe Moglia, own the record of four playoff victories.
- Bohannon is seventh in Big South history with 39 career coaching wins, and became the second-fastest Big South coach to win 35 games when he reached the benchmark with KSU's 51-14 Big South championship win over Monmouth on Nov. 10, 2018 just his 46th career game on the sideline.

SPLITTIN' THE **UPRIGHTS**

- Sophomore kicker Nathan Robertson is the only kicker at the FCS level to connect on 10-plus extra points and make four field goals this year. He ranks seventh in the country among kickers with 9.3 points per game.
- He also handles kickoff duties and has recorded one touchback on 14 tries.

- The Owls rank No. 1 in the nation in passing yards per completion, averaging 22.53 yards per completion,
- Kennesaw State leads the Big South Conference in 16 team statistical categories, including scoring offense at 41.3 points per game and scoring defense at just 11.0 points per contest.
- KSU is the only tea in the country to rank in the top 5 in the nation in total offense and total defense, ranking No. 2 on defense and No. 5 on offense.

CARRYING THE **TORCH**

- KSU's Daniel David Lamar University's Jordan Hoy and The Citadel's Brandon Rainey are the only two quarterbacks in Division I football (FBS & FCS) to have at least five rushing touchdowns this year, as they all tie with a handful of scores.
- He is tied for third in the country in rushing touchdowns with four. He also ranks 11th in the nation in scoring, averaging 11.0 points per contest.



BIG PLAY PARKER

- KSU's Joel Parker has been incredibly effective as true freshman on the defensive line for the Owls. He had an impressive fall camp and was noticed by Bohannon as a freshman that could immediately make an impact.
- Parker leads all freshman in FBS and FCS with 4.0 sacks on the season. The figure also leads the Big South, regardless of class.
- Parker is the only player in college football that has turned a 6.0 TFL and 3.0 sack performance, a feat he accomplished against Alabama State.
- Parker leads all freshman in FBS and FCS and ranks third in the FCS with 7.0 tackles-for-loss this season. He leads the conference in tackles-for-loss, as well.



KENT, OHIO- In a grind-it-out game in which the Owls controlled the ball for 39 minutes, Kennesaw State fell 26-23 in overtime to Kent State.

After deferring the toss, the Kennesaw State defense stood strong on the first possession and forced a Golden Flash punt.

Daniel David led a field-goal drive on the first possession for the Owls and the Kennesaw State found themselves on top 3-0 with 8:15 to play after Nathan Robertson knocked through a 33-yard field goal.

On the ensuing Kent State possession, the Golden Flashes tied the ball game after a 32-yard field goal. The Owls answered with their second field goal that was set up by a 34-yard reception by Bronson Rechsteiner. Robertson hit a 21-yard field goal at the 11:58 mark in the second quarter to give the Owls the lead.

The Owls third drive of the day stalled, but was kept alive after recovering a muffed Kent State punt. Daniel David found Isaac Foster streaking down the middle of the field for 32 yards on the next play. Following the reception, David found paydirt from two yards out and put the Owls on top, 13-3 midway through the second quarter.

Kent State answered with a 23-yard quarterback scramble to pull within three points with under five minutes in the first half.

The Owls capped off a nine-play 50-yard drive with a 32-yard field goal and took a 16-10 lead at the break

The Owls had a chance to put up points on the first possession of the second half after recovering a second muffed punt, but Daniel David threw his first interception of the season and the Golden Flashes took over at their 20-yard line.

Kent State took the 17-16 lead with 9:26 in the third quarter after converting a third-and-sixteen with a 75-yard touchdown pass down the sideline.

Kennesaw State looked like it was going to answer again- and thought it did- but a 43-yard rushing touchdown was called back on a holding penalty.

The KSU defense forced another three-and-out before the KSU offense converted a fourth down opportunity to push the ball into Kent State territory. On the fourth down play, David rolled out to his right and found K.J. Hancock down the right sideline who made a one-of-a-kind grab to keep the drive alive.

The Owls had their second touchdown of the day called back on the drive and couldn't pick up points after a missed field goal with 10:14 to play in the contest.

Kent State took a 20-16 lead at the 7:52 mark, but Kennesaw State answered the call and manufactured a 14-play, 75-yard drive that ended with a 4-yard rushing touchdown from Daniel David to give the Owls the three-point advantage.

On final drive of the fourth quarter, the Golden Flashes drove the ball 49 yards and made a field goal to force the game into overtime at 23-23.

On its first possession of overtime, the Owls lost control of the football and turned it over, which gave the ball to the Golden Flashes.

Kent State drove home a 43-yard field goal to capture the victory.



MONTGOMERY, Ala.- On a muggy Saturday afternoon, the No. 7 Owls throttled Alabama State 42-7 at ASU Stadium in a game that was never in question.

All things were clicking for the Owls to begin the matinée at ASU Stadium, as Tanner Jones blocked the first Alabama State attempted punt after the defense forced a three-and-out to open the game. Daniel David scored from two yards out to give the Owls the first lead of the game.

Turnover Plank made an appearance during the ensuing possession, as Demetrius Pettway intercepted the Hornets' pass attempt and took it the distance to push the advantage to two scores at the 11:55 mark in the opening quarter.

After another defensive stop, Bronson Rechsteiner capped off a 9-play, 97-yard yard drive with a 55yard run between the tackles to extend the lead to 21-0 at the end of the first quarter.

Adesola Abisoye opened up the second quarter with the Owls' second interception of the contest and set up KSU on the Hornets' side of the field. The drive ended with Tommy Bryant muscling through the Hornets' defensive line from two yards out, which put the Owls on top, 28-0 with just over nine minutes to play in the first half.

The half ended with the Owls up 28-0 after running out of time on the final drive of the second quarter. At the break, Kennesaw State had outgained the Hornets 232-78 and held a 215-to-19 advantage on the around.

The second half started much like the first- the Owls scored on their first drive of the quarter that was highlighted by a 55-yard score by Antavius Grier.

The Hornets answered with a touchdown pass at the 12-minute mark to cut the lead to 35-7. KSU scored on a 14-yard rush by Tommy Bryant, whose second score of the day put the Owls up 42-7 with 5:39 left in the third quarter

The final quarter was a defensive battle, as neither team scored and the score held 42-7 in favor of the Owls. Because the Owls' offense was effective all night, Kennesaw State's first punt of the contest came with 56 seconds in the fourth quarter.
