NUMBERS TO KNOW



» KSU has been ranked in the top 25 for 38 straight weeks, dating back to week nine of the 2017 season.



» The Owls have at least one rushing TD in 54 consecutive games, a streak that spans four full seasons.

TOP **STORYLINES**

- Kennesaw State steps out of league play this Saturday, welcoming first-year FCS member Dixie State to town as the Owls look to remain unbeaten to start the spring 2021 season.
- KSU is looking to move to 3-0 against Dixie State and match its best start in school history, a mark set during the inaugural year of the program in 2015.
- The Owls are going for their 14th consecutive non-conference regular season home win against Dixie State, a streak that dates back to the beginning of the 2016 season.
- Located 1,922 miles from Kennesaw, Georgia, Dixie State will geographically be the western-most opponent KSU has ever faced, located in Saint George, Utah. The Owls have also played Weber State (Ogden, Utah) and Montana State (Bozeman).
- The KSU defense has been unstoppable in the second and third quarters this year. In 17 drives, the Owls have allowed just 98 yards, forced nine punts, three fumbles and one turnover on downs.
- The Owls have scored in seven of eight trips to the red zone in 2021, with six touchdowns and one field goal. All six touchdowns have been rushing scores.
- Kennesaw State set a school record for time of possession last week against Charleston Southern, holding the ball for 40 minutes and 20 seconds. The longest drive of the game was 16 plays and lasted 9:56 in the first quarter.
- The Owls are coming off their 16th Big South Conference win in their last 17 tries, knocking off Charleston Southern 24-19.
- Kennesaw State is now 5-1 in Big South openers and has started 1-0 in league play each of the last four seasons.
- Kennesaw State is 29-5 all-time in Fifth Third Bank Stadium, including winning 20 of its last 21 regular season home games.

Where We Rank

- The Owls currently rank No. 2 in the country in rushing yards per game at 268.5. KSU has rushed for 200-plus yards in 18 consecutive games dating back to the 2017 season and 59 of 65 games all time.
- Kennesaw ranks No. 7 in the country in total defense through two games, surrendering 202.0 yards game.
- After holding the ball for over 40 minutes against Charleston Southern, KSU ranks seventh in the country in time of possession among teams that have played multiple games, averaging 35:15 per contest.
- The Owls rank No. 1 in the country in passing yards per completion at 27.0 after leading the nation in the category last season at 21.42.

Officially THE GOAT

• With the 24-19 win against Charleston Southern, head coach Brian Bohannon became the fastest coach in Big South history to reach 50 career coaching victories, doing so in just 65 games. The next closest coach is former Coastal Carolina HC David Bennett who needed 78 games.

TEAM NEWS & NOTES

Dynasty Mode

- Dating back to week two of the 2017 season, Kennesaw State has won 36 of its last 42 games for an 85.7 winning percentage.
- The Owls are looking for their third Big South Conference championship in the last four seasons and their fourth consecutive FCS Playoffs appearance this spring.
- KSU is looking to join Coastal Carolina as the only programs in league history to make the playoffs in four consecutive seasons.
- KSU is one of five teams in the country to win a playoff game in each of the last three seasons, joined by North Dakota State, JMU, UNI and Weber State. The Owls are also one of nine programs to appear in each of the last three FCS Playoffs.

Minute Men

• In their first five-plus seasons, the Owls have 54 scoring drives of one minute or less, including a program-best 17 last season. KSU tallied one scoring drive less than one minute in the season-opener and two more against Charleston Southern.

One-Timer

• The Owls have 29 one-play scoring drives in program history, including 18 in the last 28 games. KSU recorded a program-best three one-play touchdown drives at Missouri State during the 2019 season.

Owls Own The Big South

• In just five years of existence, Kennesaw State and head coach Brian Bohannon have four all-time playoff wins - tying the record by both a league member and head coach. Former member Coastal Carolina and its head coach, Joe Moglia, also collected four playoff victories.

The Total Package

- Kennesaw State has led the Big South Conference in total defense each of the last three seasons and has finished in the top five in the nation in total defense each of the last two years.
- KSU was the only defensive unit in the country in 2019 to rank in the top five in total defense (2) and rushing defense (5), allowing just 88.9 yards per carry on the ground.
- In the first five years of the program, the Owls never ranked outside the top 20 in the country in total defense, including back-to-back seasons inside the top five.

What a Rush

• Kennesaw State's spread option ground attack has become the most explosive rushing attack in all of FCS football, leading the nation in rushing yards per game two of the last the three seasons, including a program-record 352.9 rushing yards per game in 2018.

Peach State Pride

• Since KSU's inception, the Owls hold the second-highest winning percentage among NCAA Division I football teams in the state of Georgia (2015-pres.). In that six-year span, Kennesaw State is the only Division I program in the state to capture two conference championships.

Somethin' Special

- Junior kicker Nathan Robertson finished second in all of FCS last season with 68 PAT's. He was also 10-of-14 on field goals to finish the season with a team-high 98 points. He currently has 8 points on the year, going a perfect 8-for-8 in PAT's in 2021.
- Nicholas Jones handled punting duties for the Owls last season and averaged 40.8 yards per punt, including a season-long 55-yarder. He pinned opponents inside the 20 yard line 10 times and had 17 fair catches.

A program built on Effort, Attitude and Toughness, head coach Brian Bohannon has constructed Kennesaw State from the ground up and turned the Owls into a powerhouse program at the FCS level in just five seasons.

Hired on March 24, 2013 and tasked with building a football program from scratch, Bohannon and embraced the challenge and quickly turned Kennesaw State into the best five-year start-up program in college football history in 2019 with a 48-15 overall record, two Big South Conference championships, three straight appearances in the FCS Playoffs and four playoff victories.

Bohannon is a three-time finalist for the Eddie Robinson award as the nation's top FCS head coach, including a runner-up finish in 2018 and a third-place finish in 2017. He was named the AFCA National Coach of the Year in 2017 and is a twotime Big South Conference Coach of the Year.

He is second in Big South Conference history with 50 victories and he became the fastest coach in league history to win 50 games when he accomplished the feat in just 65 games.

In the first five years of the program, 72 national polls were released with the Owls appearing in exactly 50-percent of the rankings. Of those 72 polls, Kennesaw State was inside the top-10 41-percent of the time.

The 2019 season was the beginning of a new era in Kennesaw State football, as the original signing class moved on and gave way to a new crop of talented players hungry to continue the championship tradition. Not only did the team deliver, but they recorded the program's third-straight 11-win season and made a return trip to the FCS Playoffs where they knocked off No. 11 Wofford on the road in the opening round.

After putting the world on notice in 2017 with a 12-2 season, the Owls somehow outdid themselves during the 2018 campaign. Ranked No. 2 in the nation for much of the year, KSU earned the No. 4 overall seed in the playoffs and took an 11-game winning streak to a second consecutive quarterfinal appearance where the Owls held the third-longest home streak in the nation that dated back over two calendar years.

Bohannon, 50, put Kennesaw State on the map in 2017 when he led the Owls to a 12-2 season and an outright Big South Championship after finishing conference play undefeated at 5-0. Holding the country's top rushing offense, the Owls would make their first postseason berth in stellar fashion. getting revenge from their season-opening loss to Samford by winning 28-17 to advance

The Owls then upset No. 3 Jacksonville State in the second round by scoring 14 unanswered second-half points to win 17-7. KSU's historic run would falter in the quarterfinals in a tough 34-27 loss to No. 5 Sam Houston State, but not before solidifying a young Kennesaw State team as one of the nation's top programs.

Bohannon is married to the former Melanie Cobb. The two have three children, sons Blake and Braden, and daughter Brooke Anna.


